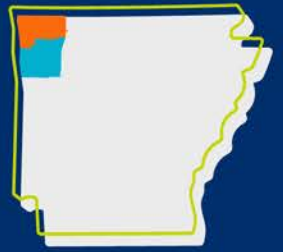

*“When my daughter, Londyn, was born, I knew my purpose was simple: **love her, protect her, and give her the best life I could.**”*

Latisha's journey has been shaped by resilience, faith, and sacrifice. A single mother, she put her dreams on hold to provide for her daughter, working hard while raising Londyn on her own. Though she dreamed of helping others through social work, stability always had to come first.

Years later, with determination and prayer, Latisha earned her Master of Social Work degree and returned to Fayetteville — a place that had once felt like home. What started as a temporary move soon became something more when Londyn, who had once planned to leave after two years, asked a simple but powerful question:

“Can we stay?”

For the first time, Latisha could imagine building a future in Northwest Arkansas. But like so many hardworking families, rising costs made homeownership feel impossible. Then she learned about Habitat for Humanity of Northwest Arkansas.

Today, Latisha and Londyn are preparing for something they've never had before — a home of their own. “For most of my daughter's life, all I could provide was apartments,” Latisha shared. “Having a safe place that truly belongs to us means everything.”

Their Habitat home represents more than walls and a roof. It means stability. Security. A place where Londyn can grow, dream, and simply be a kid. It means roots in a community they love — and the beginning of generational change.
